Travelling Instructions to Middlesbrough

Middlesbrough is in the North East of England. (See the various maps at the back of this document)

Middlesbrough Town Centre

The A19 and A66 pass within one mile of Middlesbrough. The University's main entrance and reception is at the intersection of Borough Road and Albert Road.

By car

Middlesbrough is linked to the national road network by the A1, the A19 and the A66 dual carriageways. Visitors should follow signs to the town centre from where the University is signposted.

Car Parking is available in the car park situated next to the Students' Union, accessible from Southfield Road. (see Campus map).

By coach

An extensive National Express coach service operates to and from Middlesbrough Bus Station.

By train

Middlesbrough is just half an hour away by train from Darlington Station, which operates a nationwide service. There are direct trains between Middlesbrough and Newcastle, Manchester and Manchester Airport, Leeds and York. A TransPennine Express service also operates between Middlesbrough and Liverpool.

By air

Durham Tees Valley Airport is 13 miles away from the University. The airport has flight connections to London (Heathrow) and Amsterdam (Schipol), which are major European hubs for international flights. Plus there are scheduled flights to other British and international airports.

By Bus and Rail



Sky Express service 737 offers direct connections daily to and from Durham Tees Valley Airport and Darlington Train Station, allowing onward connections to Middlesbrough Train Station.

The dedicated bus service is free for air passengers.

Alternatively, Arriva operate a bus service from Durham Tees Valley to Middlesbrough Town Hall:

By Taxi

Taxis are available directly outside the terminal building and it will cost approximately £17 to Middlesbrough.

From Middlesbrough Train Station

By Taxi

Taxis are available directly outside the train station and will cost approximately £2.60 to the University.

If no taxis are available, ring Boro Taxis on (01642) 226688 or 222333.

On Foot

The train station is only a 5 minute walk from the University along Albert Road (see Middlesbrough map).

Accommodation Information

Delegates staying in University Rooms

Delegates staying in the University Halls of Residence will be allocated a room in Hall 1 of Woodlands Halls on Victoria Road (labelled 'B' on the Campus Map).

Keys are to be collected from the LRC Security Office upon arrival (open 24 hours a day, 13 on the Campus Map).


Delegates staying in the Thistle Hotel




